

## ***Margarita Salas and María Zambrano Postdoctoral Fellowships 2022***

The High Energy Physics Group ([Grupo de Altas Energías - GAE](#)) at [Universidad Complutense de Madrid \(UCM\)](#) is seeking outstanding candidates to apply for the *Margarita Salas* and *María Zambrano* competitive Spanish fellowship programs. The specifics for each of the programs follow:

- Postdoctoral Fellowship program *Margarita Salas*
  - A two-year contract for Spanish candidates who obtained a Ph.D. in a non-Spanish University between June 2020 and May 2022.

- Postdoctoral Fellowship program *María Zambrano*
  - A two-year contract for candidates with a minimum of two-year postdoctoral experience.

The GAE-UCM has an ample trajectory in the fields of experimental astroparticle physics and high energy astrophysics, with scientific interests ranging from the study of active galactic nuclei, pulsars to dark matter searches and unidentified gamma-ray sources. The group participates in the ground-based gamma-ray facilities [CTA](#) and [MAGIC](#) and collaborates in the space-based *Fermi* - Large Area Telescope. The successful candidate is expected to join and develop most of her/his work within these international collaborations.

For both *Margarita Salas* and *María Zambrano* programs, GAE-UCM must act as host, and thus it will perform an internal selection.
